The Jay County Public Library will re-open to the public on Tuesday, May 26! It's been a long time and we are excited to see you again! Starting out we will have limited hours, open 8:00 to 5:00 each weekday. Hours will gradually expand over the next six weeks.

We are re-opening with the guidance of the Jay County Health Department and are doing all we can to make the library a safe place for all to enjoy. If you are hesitant about coming into the building, take the time you need to feel at ease before coming back. That's what is important to us - that you're safe and feel at ease when you are back in the library. Curbside delivery will still be available.

In an effort to increase safety for our patrons and staff, things for the next six weeks will look a little different - our furniture will be temporarily unavailable, our front desk area will have three spaces where we would like all patron-staff interactions to take place, public computers will have a 45-minute time limit per day for each user, the fun stuff on the children's side of the building will not be available. All items returned will be sanitized before they go back out again.

We strongly encourage all patrons to wash or sanitize their hands when entering the building and also expect patrons to observe physical distancing. We are allowing each individual to make their own decision on wearing a mask. There will also be regular sanitizing of high traffic touch points.
