Summit City Disc Dog Demonstration

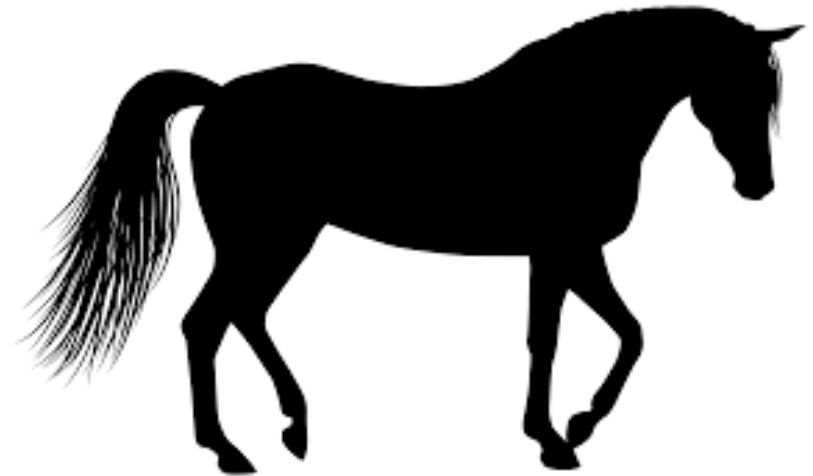
