Stop by the new children's materials shelf and check one out today.

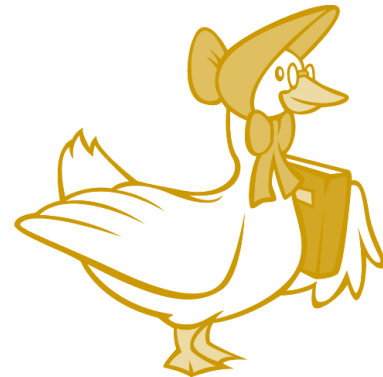
The Young Hoosier Book Award is a long-standing award designed to promote reading and books that would interest students from young children to early teens. The books are divided into three age categories and are a

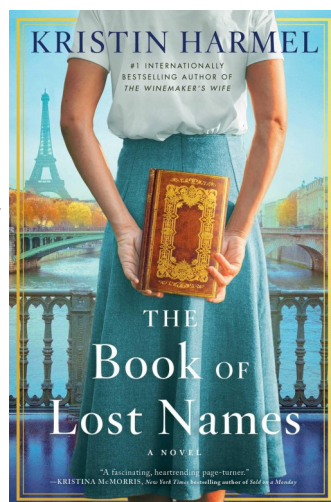
