


### LOCAL AUTHORS VISIT JCPL!

time between his home state of Indiana and Arizona. This will be an event you will not want to miss!



### MRS. MACDONALD'S HARVEST


Mrs. MacDonald returns to the library on Saturday, October 9 at 10 a.m. to talk about harvest on the farm!

## **LEND A HAND, GIVE A CAN!**


JCPL is showing love to our community by hosting a non-perishable food drive from October 18 through November 13. Everyone is welcome to


