BLOOD DRIVE

This holiday season, the Red Cross and JCPL are hosting a blood drive in the Community Room at the library on December 29, from 12-6 p.m. Donors must bring photo ID, donor card, or use the Blood Donor app. All donors and volunteers are required to wear a mask over the mouth and nose. Donors are encouraged to sign up for RapidPass at redcrossblood.org/rapidpass, to make the donation process quicker. Donors who are at least 19 years of age must weigh at least 110 pounds and be in good health. Donors who are 16-18 must have a signed consent form and meet special height and weight criteria. For eligibility questions, call 1-866-236-3276, select option 3 and then option 1. Donors should remember to eat well-balanced meals and drink extra water before and after donating. No children or people who are not donating will be permitted in the donor room due to Red Cross social distancing policies.
