






**The Perfect Assassin– By: James Patterson (Doc Savage #1)**




**A Wish for Winter– By: Viola Shipman**




**The Choice– By: Nora Roberts (Dragon Heart Legacy #3)**




**Hunting Time– By: Jeffery Deaver (Colter Shaw #4)**




**The Whittiers– By: Danielle Steel**






**A World of Curiosities– By: Louise Penny (Chief Inspector Gamache #18)**
