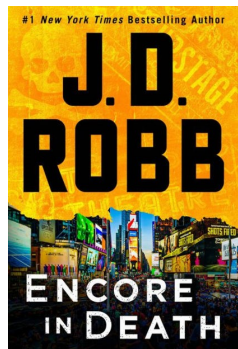

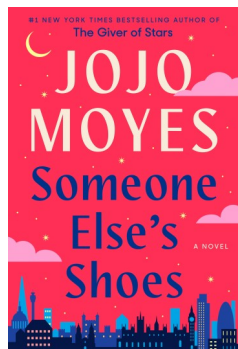


### Every Good Gift– By: Kelly Irvin

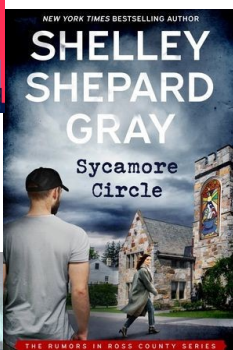


### Someone Else's Shoes– By: Jojo Moyes

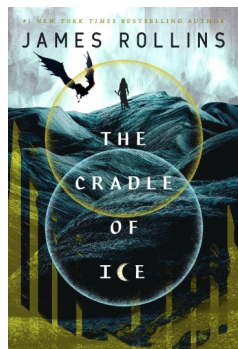


### Sycamore Circle– By: Shelley Shepard Gray

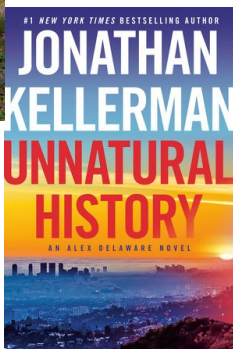


### The Promise of Easter– By: Marta Perry

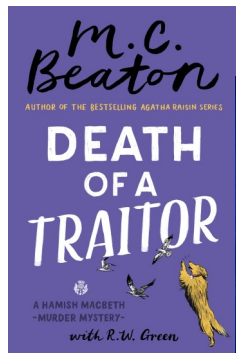
### Unnatural History– By: Jonathan Kellerman

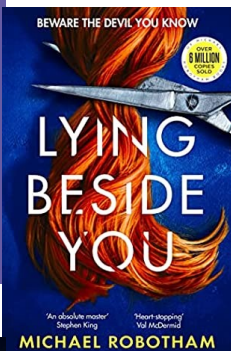


### **Death of a Traitor– By: M. C. Beaton**

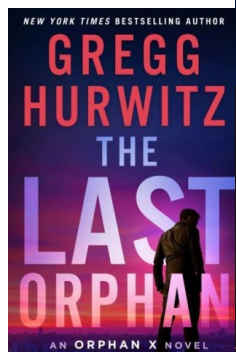


### **Lying Beside You– By: Michael Robotham**

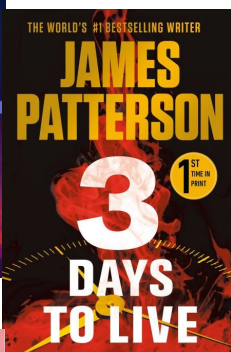


### **The Last Orphan– By: Greg Hurwitz**

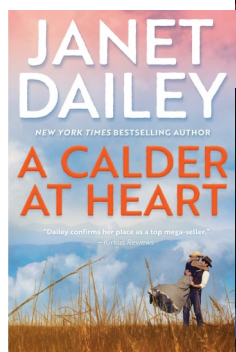


### **Three Days to Live– By: James Patterson**

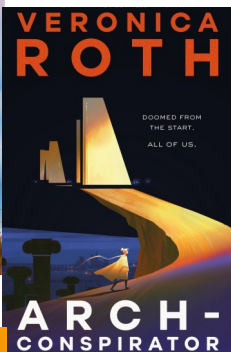


### **A Calder at Heart– By: Janet Dailey**

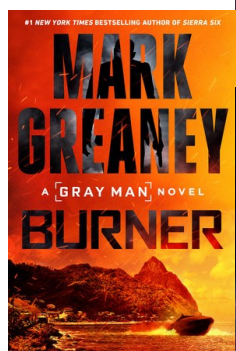


### **Arch Conspirator– By: Veronica Roth**

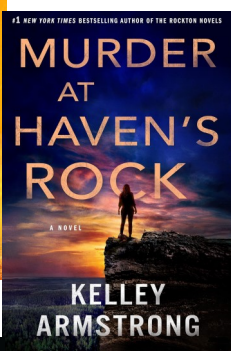


### **Burner– By: Mark Greaney**

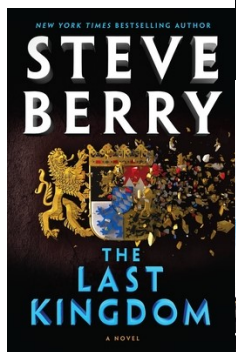


### **Murder at Haven's Rock– By: Kelley Armstrong**

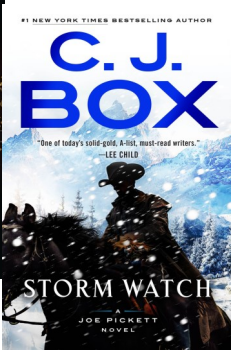


### **The Last Kingdom– By: Steve Berry**
