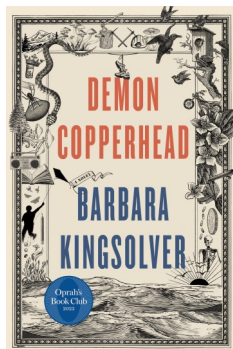

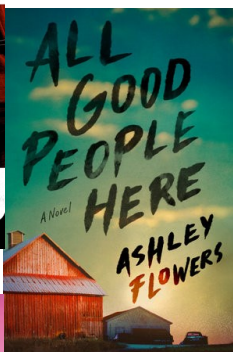

An innocent father serving life for the murder of his own son receives evidence that his child may still be alive, and must break out of prison to find out the truth.

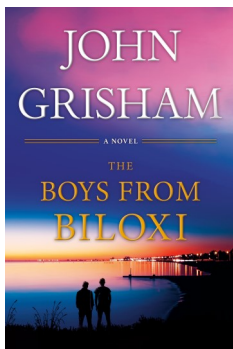

A journalist uncovers her hometown's dark secrets when she becomes obsessed with the unsolved murder of a childhood neighbor—and another disappearance 20 years later.

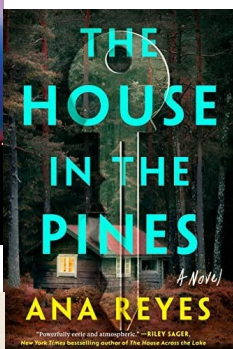

A sweeping saga of two sons of immigrant families who grow up as friends, but ultimately find themselves on opposite sides of the law. Life itself hangs in the balance.

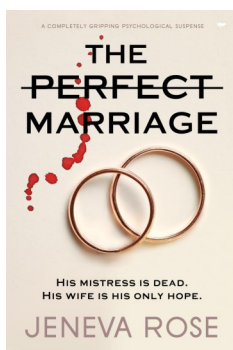

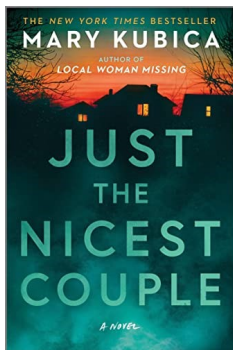

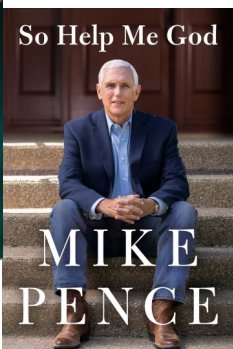
