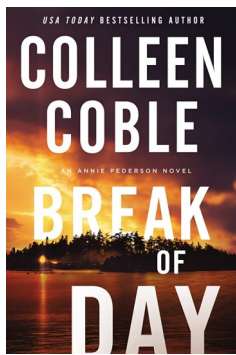

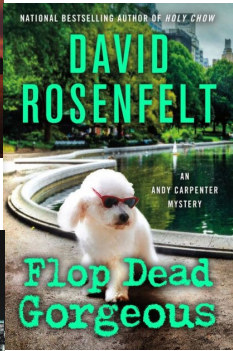


Break of Day– By: Colleen Coble

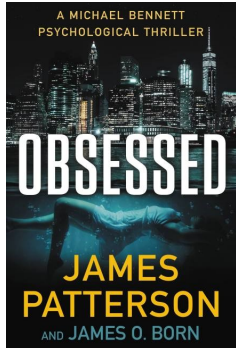


Flop Dead Gorgeous– By: David Rosenfelt

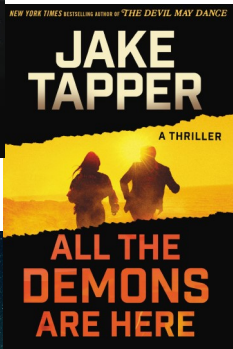


Obsessed– By: James Patterson

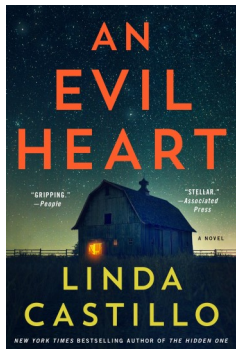


All the Demons Are Here– By: Jake Tapper

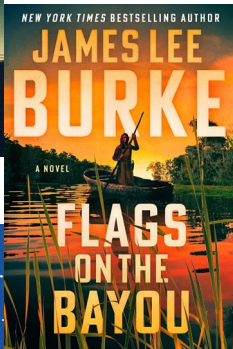


An Evil Heart– By: Linda Castillo

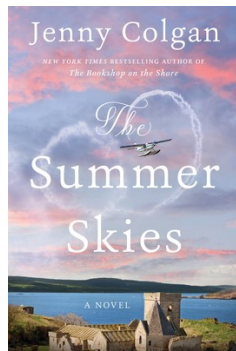
The Paris Agent– By: Kelly Rimmer

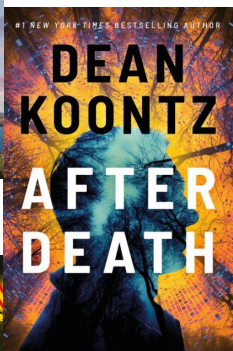


The Summer Skies– By: Jenny Colgan

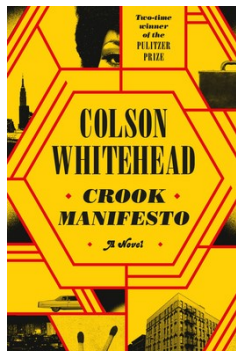


After Death– By: Dean Koontz

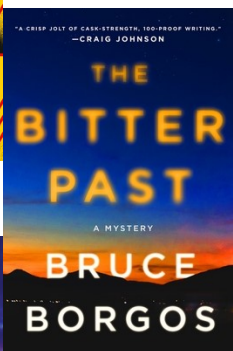


Crook Manifesto– By: Colson Whitehead

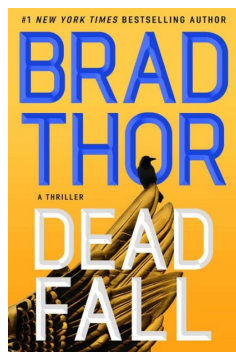


An Honest Man– By: Michael Koryta

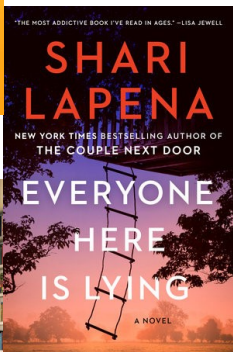


Dead Fall– By: Brad Thor

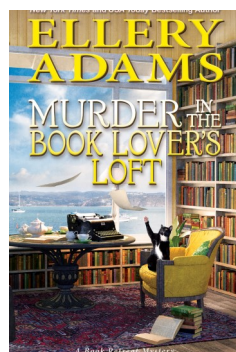


Everyone Here is Lying– By: Shari Lapena
