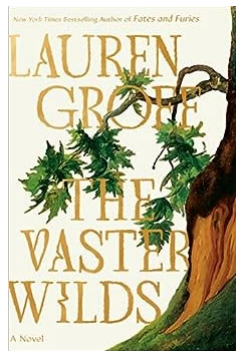

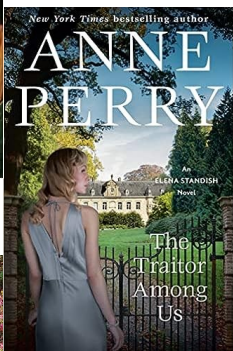


The Vaster Wilds– By: Lauren Groff
